



The Annapolis West Health Foundation (AWHF) Student Health Program Bursary is an initiative to assist individuals entering a health-related education program at the University or Community College level. The Program is open to current year graduating students of Annapolis West Education Centre (AWEC), as well as past graduates of AWEC. Applications will also be accepted from students currently enrolled in a Health-Related Education Program at the University or Community College level who are in their second, third or fourth year of studies.

Although this Bursary is only open to graduating students, it is strongly recommended that under-graduates in the Grades 9 – 11 should be planning their studies to meet the requirements for future careers in the Health-Related Sciences.

Competing Students are asked to complete the Annapolis West Health Foundation Student Health Program Bursary application form in full and submit it to the Foundation office at the address below. The application should include a current resume of work and extra-curricular activities, your academic standing in your current program of study as well as career and community goals. A short list of applicants will be interviewed by the AWHF Education Committee and a successful candidate chosen from those interviewed.

A Bursary of \$4000 will be presented to the University or Community College of the successful applicant at the completion of their first term of studies and presentation of their first term transcript of marks from the educational institution.
